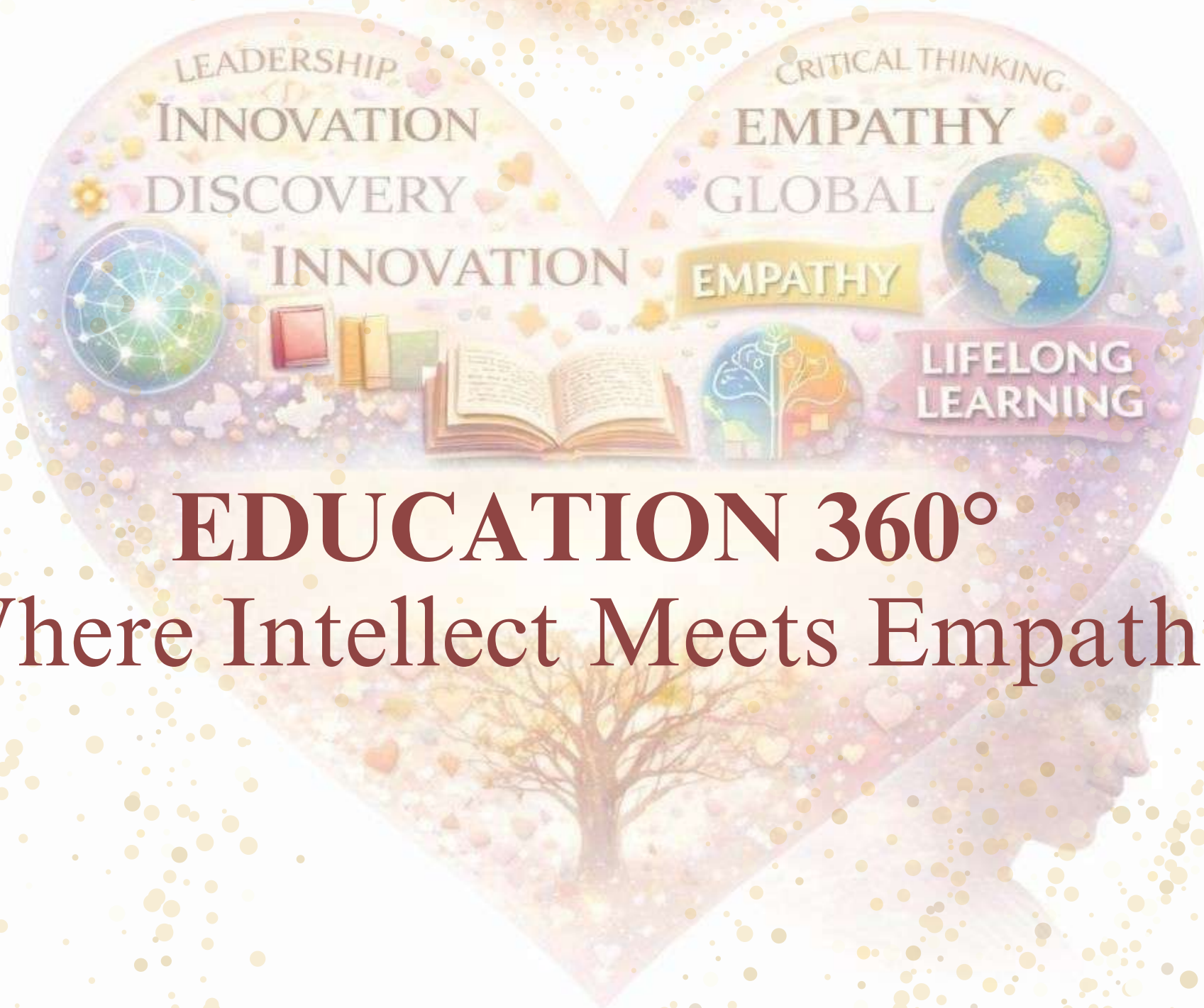

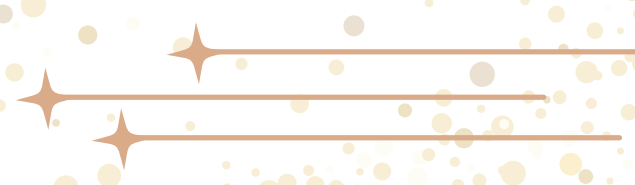

As a chairman, I have consciously worked towards creating school environments where children feel secure, valued, and heard. Initiatives such as life skills programs, mindfulness practices, open forums, and peer engagement have contributed to building a more inclusive and supportive culture. I have observed that even small efforts—listening patiently, encouraging participation, or acknowledging a student’s feelings—can create a significant and lasting impact.

I have always believed that true schooling is not defined by how much a child knows, but by how well a child understands, adapts, and cares. As Mahatma Gandhi wisely said, “By education, I mean an all-round drawing out of the best in child and man—body, mind and spirit.” This thought deeply resonates with my vision of what meaningful schooling should strive to achieve.

Over the years, my journey as a school chairman has given me valuable insights into what truly shapes a child’s growth. Academic excellence is important, but it is only one dimension. Real transformation happens when intellectual development is balanced with emotional strength and empathy.

In my experience, I have often seen students who perform exceptionally well in academics yet struggle to express themselves, collaborate, or cope with setbacks. I recall interacting with a high-achieving student who had suddenly become withdrawn and disengaged. What initially appeared to be a dip in performance was, in reality, the weight of constant expectations and an unspoken fear of failure. With timely support from our counseling team and consistent encouragement from teachers, the student gradually regained confidence and developed a healthier perspective towards success and self-worth.

Such experiences reinforce the importance of looking beyond marks and understanding the deeper needs of every child. This is where the role of psychology teachers and school counsellors becomes indispensable. In the classroom, psychology educators help students explore emotions, behaviour, and relationships, fostering self-awareness and sensitivity. Beyond the classroom, counselors provide a safe, non-judgmental space where students can express themselves openly and receive the guidance they need.

As Maria Montessori beautifully expressed, “The greatest sign of success for a teacher is to be able to say, ‘The children are now working as if I did not exist.’” This reflects the true goal of education—empowering children to become confident, independent, and self-aware individuals.



A Polar Origin of the Vedas?

I humbly present ideas that pull me, based on the works of Hon' Shri Lokmanya Bal Gangadhar Tilak one of the foremost leaders of Bharat's Freedom Struggle and also an interpreter of ancient texts. In the midst of colonial rule, when asserting India's cultural and historical depth was itself an act of resistance, it turned to the Vedas not merely as scripture, but as a testament to the antiquity and dignity of Indian civilisation.

Lokmanya Tilak's Vision - Northern Cities of Arkaim

At the beginning of the twentieth century, Lokmanya Tilak proposed one of the most unusual and imaginative hypotheses about the origins of the Vedic people. In his remarkable work **The Arctic Home in the Vedas**, propounding that the earliest ancestors of the Vedic tradition may once have lived in far northern regions of the earth, possibly near the Arctic Circle. This was not a casual speculation. Rather, it emerged from his close and sustained reading of the Rigveda, where he believed certain descriptions of natural phenomena made far better sense in polar latitudes than in the tropical environment of India.

One of the central pieces of evidence Tilak examined was the depiction of dawn, the goddess Uṣā. In several hymns of the Rigveda, dawn is not described as a brief daily event, but as something prolonged, recurring, and almost stretched across time. A well-known verse (Rigveda 1.113) speaks of the dawns that indicate continuity rather than a single fleeting appearance:

“बह्विःउषासीःशशमानीःअभवून्” ॐ
bahviḥ uṣāsaḥ śaśamānāḥ abhūvan

“Many dawns have shone forth continuously.”

Tilak interpreted such passages not merely as poetic embellishment, but as reflections of a real natural experience—what we today understand as the long Arctic twilight, where the sun remains near the horizon for extended periods, creating a prolonged dawn-like glow. As he wrote:

“The Vedic poets speak of dawns that linger and follow one another without interruption, a phenomenon which finds its natural explanation only in the Arctic regions.”

A second important strand in Tilak's reasoning comes from ancient Indian cosmological conceptions of time. In several traditional sources, we encounter the idea that one day and one night of the Gods correspond to a full year of humans. This idea appears, for example, in texts like the Mahabharata and later Puranic literature:

“देवानां ददवसो वष” ॐ
devānām divaso varṣam

“A day of the gods is a year (of humans).”

Tilak argues that it may preserve a memory of polar conditions. Near the Arctic Circle, the sun remains above the horizon for approximately six months (a continuous “day”) and below it for another six months (a continuous “night”), making a full cycle equivalent to a human year. He therefore argued



“A day and a night of the gods correspond to a year of men – an idea which becomes perfectly intelligible when viewed in the light of the polar day and polar night.” – Tilak

From this perspective, Vedic cosmology appears to be observational–rooted in experiences of extreme natural cycles.

Nearly a century after Tilak advanced these ideas, archaeology introduced an unexpected and fascinating development. In 1987, researchers discovered the **Bronze Age settlement of Arkaim in the southern Ural steppe**. This site, associated with the **Sintashta culture**, dates roughly between 2100 and 1700 BCE—a period often linked with the early Indo-Iranian world.

What struck archaeologists most about Arkaim was its design. It is a circular, fortified settlement with concentric defensive walls, radial streets, and houses arranged in a highly organized pattern around a central open space. Such planning suggests not only technical sophistication, but also the possibility of symbolic or cosmological meaning embedded in the layout. The discovery of Arkaim was followed by the identification of several similar settlements in the region, collectively referred to as the “Land of Towns.”

Within these sites, archaeologists uncovered evidence of advanced bronze metallurgy, fortified habitation, and ritual activity. Most notably, they found some of the earliest known chariot burials. This is particularly significant because the chariot occupies a central place in both Vedic and Iranian traditions. In the Rigveda, Gods such as **Indra** and the **Aśvins** are frequently described as riding chariots, and the chariot becomes both a ritual and symbolic vehicle in later texts.

For some scholars and enthusiasts, the discovery of Arkaim seemed to provide a geographical context that resonates—at least broadly—with the migration patterns described in Tilak’s hypothesis. Although Tilak himself had no knowledge of this site, the Eurasian steppe region does lie along the routes through which Indo-Iranian cultures are believed to have spread toward Iran and India.

In more recent times, certain modern Russian thinkers, sometimes referred to as “Russian Vedists,” have drawn parallels between ancient Slavic traditions and Vedic ideas. Figures such as **Valery Chudinov** have proposed that the Eurasian steppe may have once hosted a shared cultural and symbolic tradition, fragments of which survive in different mythologies. While such interpretations are not widely accepted in mainstream scholarship, they reflect

a continuing effort to connect textual, archaeological, and mythological evidence across regions.

What makes the intersection of Tilak’s theory and the archaeology of the Eurasian steppe so compelling is not that it provides definitive answers, but that it opens a space for dialogue between different kinds of knowledge. We are dealing here with poetic texts, astronomical observations, and material remains—each offering a different lens on the past.

Tilak himself emphasized that the Vedic hymns should not be read merely as ritual compositions, but as records of human experience shaped by the natural world. As he wrote:

“The hymns of the Veda are not merely religious compositions; they are also the oldest records of the human mind responding to the great spectacles of nature.”

Seen in this light, the long dawns of the north, the windswept steppe landscapes, and the sacred verses of the Rigveda begin to form a single, though still incomplete, historical imagination—one that stretches across geography and time.
